In no way will an automated decision-making process (profiling) be applied to your personal data.

Type of personal data processed:

- Data relating to an identifier, such as a name, location, contact details, etc.;
- Data relating to the economic activities of the concerned party.

Method of processing

The personal data collected will be processed with:

- corporate IT systems and paper archives, in compliance with the Security Measures provided for by art. 32 of the GDPR;
- personal data will be processed by appointed persons in charge of processing appointed as pursuant to art. 29 of the GDPR.
