Purpose of processing

Your data will be processed for the following purposes based on the related legal bases:

Method of processing

The personal data collected will be processed with:

- corporate IT systems and paper archives, in compliance with the Security Measures provided for by art. 32 of the GDPR;
- resumes sent through the appropriate section of the company website will be received by a dedicated email address;
- personal data will be processed by appointed persons in charge of processing appointed as pursuant to art. 29 of the GDPR.
